Kate: Until Leaves Fall in Paris by Sarah Sundin-Set in 1940s Paris, Lucy Girard, an American Ballerina, buys her friends' bookstore so the owners can escape the Nazis to America. As she struggles to run Green Leaf Books, due to all the harsh conditions, she begins to work with the resistance letting the store become a place of hidden messages within the pages of her books to stop the enemy. Bluebird by Sharon Cameron- Set in 1946 Berlin. Eva leaves behind the ruins of the war and heads to New York City. Eva herself holds the key to a deadly secret: Project Bluebird-containing horrific experiments done in concentration camps that could tip the scales of balance and world power. Wanted by both the Soviets and Americans, Eva came to America with a sole purpose...to hunt down a Nazi and find justice.
